

# SCARBOROUGH | ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Looking for additional information about our league in Scarborough? You've come to the right place.

#### ONE | REGISTRATION, GENERAL NOTES, RULES

- All registrations must be completed online and payment **must be made to complete your** registration
- Team entries and individual players must be **paid in full** prior to May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020
- Minimum of 12 games (including playoffs) throughout the season
- Bye week and double headers (back-to-back games) may occur during the season
- Teams will require a minimum of one volunteer coach on the bench
  - Volunteer coaches will be required to provide the league with a Criminal/Vulnerable Sector Check prior to May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020
- **Teams** may only dress a maximum of nine (9) skaters and one (1) goaltender each game
  - Team entries may roster up to 11 skaters and one (1) goalie. Rosters are not able to change throughout the season.
  - Coaches entering a team are responsible for ensuring the team fee is paid in full.
  - Coaches will also provide their players with a per-player fee to ensure the total team fee is fulfilled
  - Coaches must ensure that they have enough players on a team when entering a team registration. There is no guarantee that the league will be able to back-fill any remaining spots on a team roster
  - If coaches are unsure if they have enough players, it's recommended that they register their child as an individual player and request to be placed on the same team as a friend(s)
- Individual Teams compromised of individually registered players will consist of nine (9) skaters and one (1) goaltender.

- The league may register **Alternate Players (AP's)** if a division is completely full. The AP fee is \$100 + HST with registrations taking place over the phone.
  - Alternate Players may be contacted to play for any individual team in need of players on a week to week basis
  - Alternate Players may play 12 games or 0 games; there is no guarantee for games played, and money will not be refunded in the event you do not play enough games.
  - Any coach/team using an alternate player for their game must let the convener know prior to the game so they can make note of it on the game sheet.
  - Alternate Players may not receive a helmet sticker.
- **Female players** may play one (1) age group down, with the exception of Atom-aged female players who will not be permitted to play in the Novice age group.

### TWO | **DIVISIONS** + **PARITY**

- Skills and Games: This is an introductory division to our 3-on-3 league. The program is 12 sessions long with the first 1/3 of the session focusing on development and skills. The next 1/3 of the program will focus on skill development while also incorporating game play with no referees. Finally, the last 1/3 of the session will be specifically game play
  - Program plan will be subject to change depending on the number of participants
- Novice Division:
  - Referees: 1 per game
  - Game Time: Majority of the games will be played 7am 1pm
  - This will also be determined by the number of teams we have in this division
  - Buzzer System Line Changes every 2 minutes
  - Games Played full ice
- Atom, Peewee, Bantam, and Midget/Juvenile:
  - Atom: Majority of the games 7am-1pm
  - *Peewee: Majority of the games 9am–3pm*
  - Bantam: Majority of the games 11am–5pm
  - Midget/Juvenile: Majority of the games 11am–6pm
    - Game times are also determined and based on how many teams we have in each division
- Skill Level:
  - Players will be split up based on skill level, including house league and rep divisions. Rep players are not permitted to play in a house league division under any condition. If a rep player wants to play with a friend – who is a house league player – the house league player will need to play up

 If the league finds players violating this rule they will be removed from the division and placed in the appropriate division. If there is no appropriate division with open spots, they will be removed from the league without a refund.

#### THREE | SCHEDULES

- We will do our best to balance teams according to skill levels.
- We will only release the first few weeks of the schedule to start in order to evaluate the teams and make any necessary divisional changes.
- We will subsequently post an additional schedule to see how the adjustments were. If adjustments were deemed to be positive, we will post the remainder of the season. If not, there may be additional divisional changes that take place.
- Game times will fluctuate week to week for all divisions
- Playoffs will consist of a minimum of 2 games.

## FOUR | COACHES

- Team Coaches
  - Coaches meeting will be drop in style and take place April 27th between 1pm and 8pm
  - Coaches can drop in during this time period pick up their jerseys and provide us with their vulnerable sector check.
  - Teams must be paid in full prior to first game.
  - The league would like for only the coaches to contact the staff with questions and concerns.
- Individual Team Coaches
  - If you are interested in volunteering your time, please make note of this during your child's registration. Once the teams are set (approximately 1-2 weeks prior to season start date) you will be notified if you have a team. Prior to the first day we will contact y ou and ask your permission to provide your contact information to your team. We will also provide you with a roster at the first game so you can obtain the contacts from the parents you may have missed.
  - The league would like for only the coaches to contact the staff with questions and concerns.

#### FIVE | ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Individual Registration
  - o The league will place individual registrants on a similarly skilled team
  - If you wish to play with a friend, please make note of the request during the registration process
- Helmet Stickers
  - All registered players will receive their Calko Group Youth Hockey League helmet sticker prior to their first game. The sticker is a proof of registration and league staff and/or referees could remove any player from a game if they're discovered to be playing without a helmet sticker.
  - o Games may be forfeited if discovered that a team is using an illegal goalie or player
  - A game may be forfeited if any team is found using players/goalies who are not registered in the league and coaches will be subject to further disciplinary action.
  - Please play fair!
- First Game Sign In:
  - All parents/guardians must sign in with league staff on their first night of play to receive their 3 on 3 helmet sticker.
  - Coaches will sign in as well to receive their jerseys and hand in any missing documentation.
- Refund Policy:
  - Withdrawal requests made more than 14 days prior to registration deadline will be eligible for a refund
  - Withdrawal requests made within 14 days of the registration deadline will be eligible for a refund, with an administrative fee of \$25 + HST per registration
  - No refunds will be given if the withdrawal request has been made after the registration deadline
  - If a participant is unable to take part in the league due to a medical issue, they will have the choice of a full refund or credit towards a future Canlan program. Valid medical documentation is required, and no refunds or credits will be provided for previous games played that were missed by the participant.
